2. **Give examples of what causes you to drift away.**

3. VS 3 What are we cautioned not to ignore?

4. **VSS 3b What does the "great salvation" mean to you? Who first announced it and how was it confirmed?**

5. VS 4 How else did God show that the great salvation was true?

6. Through Hebrew 1 - 2:4, the author has established the supremacy of Jesus compared to angels and prophets; from this passage what does Jesus mean for believers?

7. **Read VSS 5-8 How does the Psalmist describe man? How does this text humble us as God's people?**

8. Verse 9: When Jesus came to earth in human form, what was his position compared to angels? How did this change?

9. **Read VSS 10-13 What do these verses mean to you? What does it mean for us that Jesus is not ashamed to call us brothers?**

10. VS 16-18 Why did Jesus have to be made "like his brothers (you and me) in every way? Mar

11. **Reading again VS 16-18, why was it necessary for Jesus to be made like us in order that he might become a merciful and faithful high priest?**
